## Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: “How has God met your needs?”



## Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “Who have you helped lately? Who has helped you?”



## Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, thank You for seeing our biggest need and taking care of it by sending Jesus to die for our sins and rise again. Help us remember that nothing is too big for You.”
